



ÉLJHS REMEMBRANCE DAY CEREMONY NOVEMBER 7, 2025

École Leduc Junior High School students and staff will observe Remembrance Day on **Friday**, **November 7, 2025**, during two identical ceremonies.

As we prepare for our upcoming Remembrance Day ceremony, we kindly ask that you speak with your child about the importance of maintaining a respectful and sombre tone throughout the event. This ceremony is a time to honour and reflect on the sacrifices made by many, and our goal is to keep the atmosphere one of respect and quiet reflection. Additionally, please remind students that hats are not to be worn during the proceedings. Hats will be removed before entering the event space as a sign of respect, similar to when we stand for the national anthem. We greatly appreciate your support to help create a meaningful experience for everyone involved.

The first ceremony will take place at 8:45, and the second will follow at 9:45, with a 15-minute break in between. Everything will be completed by 10:30.

2025-2026 Student Enrollment Verification Form for Black Gold School Division is available on the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

Please completed this process before **November 30th**, **2025**. Completion of this form ensures that we have accurate information for emergency communication. If you fail to complete this form, your child's ability to leave school grounds for walking field trips, as well as participating in class/team photos or being recognized in other school materials may be compromised.

In order to confirm your child's registration with Black Gold School Division, you must have:

- An active PowerSchool Parent Portal Account.
- An Internet connected computer, tablet, or phone.

- * **DON'T RUSH TO CATCH THE BUS**: When roads and walkways are slippery, plan to arrive a little earlier so you do not have to rush.

- 6. Invite your student to login to their account and click their name in the top right-hand corner. Select **My Links** and accept your link invitation
