The Alberta government announced their Re-entry Plan for the 2020-21 school year to allow schools and parents to prepare for learning while putting student and staff safety first. ### REGISTRATION OF NEW STUDENTS & RETURNING STUDENTS

Registration of New Students will be addressed between August 26 - 28, 2020.

You will be asked to upload the following documents upon registration.

- Birth Certificate or Canadian Residency Documents
- Proof of residency (eg. a copy of drivers licence with address on it)
- Final report card from previous school

Students who were registered in Black Gold School Division in 2019-2020 and are returning to a Black Gold School in 2020-2021, should NOT complete a new student registration form. Instead, they could complete an online Student Enrolment Verification Form, through their [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#). The form will be

available prior to September 1, 2020.

## CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDING IN-SCHOOL CLASSES OR LEARNING AT HOME

BGSD will distribute a form via SchoolMessenger, for parents to declare which learning experience is best for each of their children and in doing so, make a 5 month (one semester) commitment until the end of January.
